A day of festivities featuring a health and wellness fair, games, food, and sunshine!

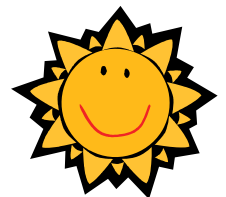
